This year, 11 students participated in the Rising CEOs program with 3 businesses funded, and Am'Agyn Spencer, a sophomore at Duchesne Academy and the 2024 Rising CEOs Champion founded Neighborhood Nannies. Her passion for community brought her to Rising CEOs, where she was able to blend her leadership and entrepreneurial goals. MAC Scholarships

Supporting BIPOC students in Accounting, Finance, Law, and STEM, our scholarships encourage academic excellence. We've awarded \$24,000 in scholarships to 24 area students since 2023. She is committed to advancing inclusive finance policies through research and leadership in public administration.



Umoja Forum Series


